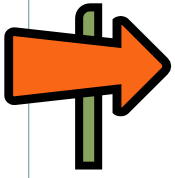

Need to do some research over the holiday? Don't panic! We have resources that you can access from home 24/7! From [Academic Search Complete](#) to [WestLaw Campus Research](#), the library's research databases are accessible from home.

Simply go to the library's homepage, www.library.calu.edu, and select the resource you need. A off-campus login page will automatically pop up. Then login with EITHER your Cal U ID Card number (16 digits) and last name OR by selecting Cal U as your institution, and entering in the username and password you use for your Cal U email (without the @calu.edu).
